Description Provide a short description of the event and its activities.				

On April 24, 2024, an online conference was held summarizing 2 years of implementation of our international YOUth 4 EU project, financed by EU funds from the CERV 2021-2027

Program, in which our partners and young people from Poland, the Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Greece and Italian.

The meeting was an opportunity to present the CERV program, implemented activities and results of the project, share good practices in bringing cities and youth closer to the European Union, share young people's memories of what they learned during the project and present new opportunities and generate new ideas for joint activities.

Overall, over 1,200 people took part in the project, the vast majority of whom were young people aged 16 to 25 and representatives of local governments and youth organizations. We organized 6 international events (1 in each country), with over 50 workshops, conferences, debates, competitions, discussion meetings and study visits. We dealt in particular with European Union topics, including disinformation, ecology, security, social activity, youth policy, EU values, democracy and European citizenship. I involved over 40 organizations in the activities - schools, universities, non-governmental organizations, local governments and organizations supporting EU policies such as Eurodesk or Europe Direct.

A very important aspect was the inclusion of young people - also those with fewer opportunities - in activities, including international ones. A total of 80 young people took part in international events - for many it was the first opportunity to participate in projects and learn about new cultures, use a foreign language and get involved in new initiatives.

For example, Wiktoria learned more about the EU, improved her English and became more confident. Piotr could learn more about the Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship and the EU, meet new people, make friends and discover new perspectives. He also realized that Rotterdam was his favorite city in Europe. Klaudia learned many valuable things, gained new inspiration for projects, took part in an Oxford debate on ecology and made lifelong friends. Julia learned more about European law, the European Parliament, the problems faced by the EU, had many valuable conversations and met new friends.

During the conference, there was a debate on how cities can bring the European Union closer to young people. Valuable EU initiatives were presented, such as Europe Goes Local (supporting youth policies in local governments) and Democracy Reloading (supporting the inclusion of young people in decision-making processes).

The conference was also an excellent opportunity for joint brainstorming to generate new ideas for joint activities and continuation of project activities in a refreshed formula. We have developed new ideas for activities that we plan to implement as part of new projects.

The meeting also discussed the upcoming elections to the European Parliament and what young people can do to encourage their adult friends and family to vote.
